

Anıtkabir is the mousoleum of our country's founder, M. Kemal Atatürk. His grave and peculiars are in mousoleum.




This on the photo is the miniature of Antıkabir. This is the part that shows Struggle of Independence with the sound effects.

 The Old Turkish Grand National Assembly-It has been used until 1960. Now, It's a museum called 'Republic Museum.'






'The Monument of Victory' was built for the women who helps Turkish soldiers on the term of wars.

There're graves of Roman people and there is a bath. Bath has developed warming system if we compare to ruins of its time.






