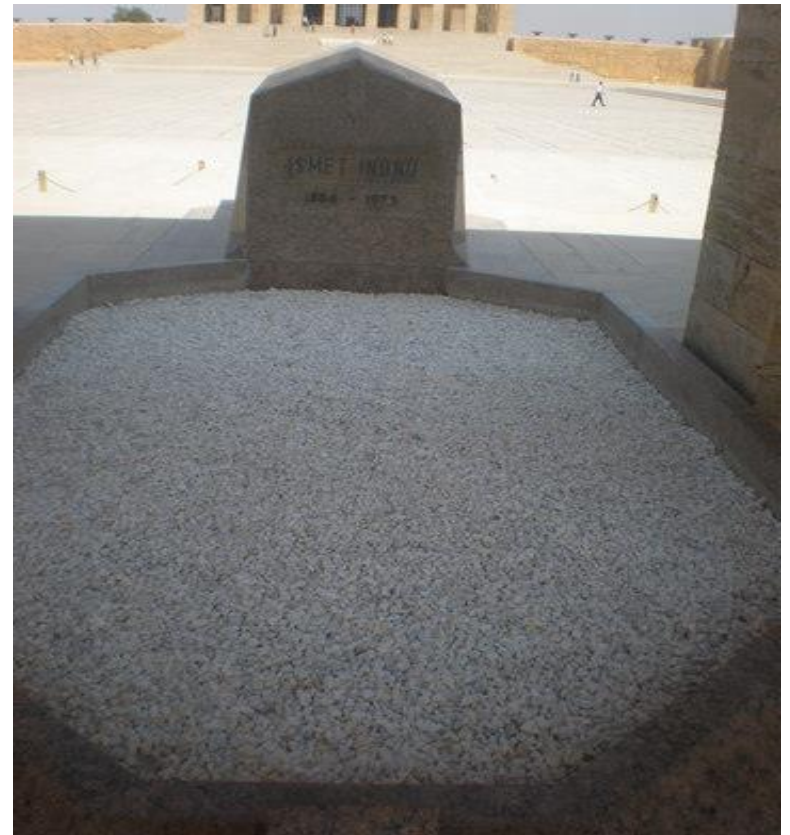
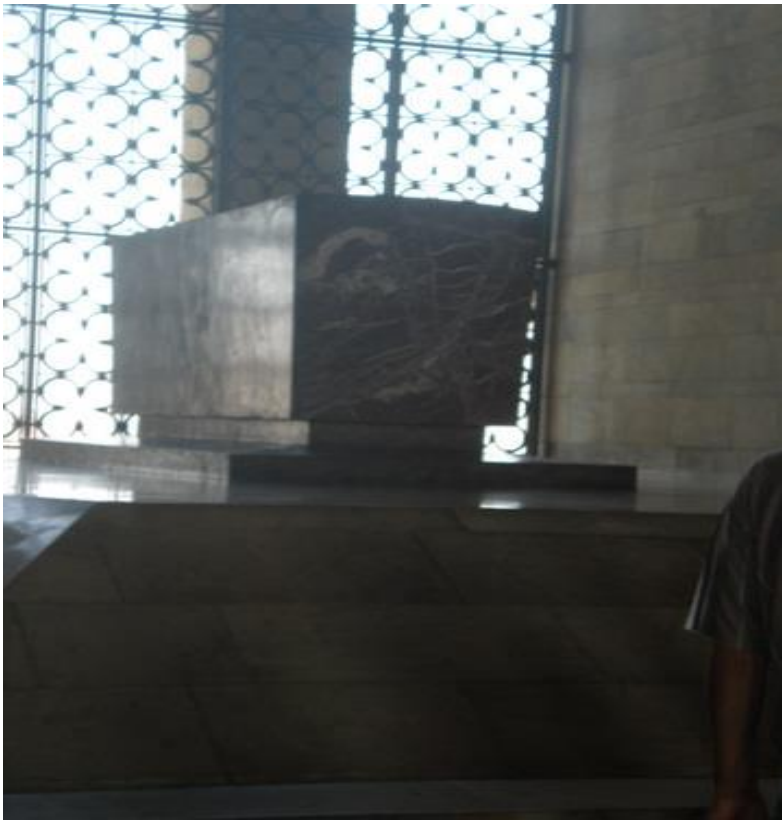
ANITKABİR

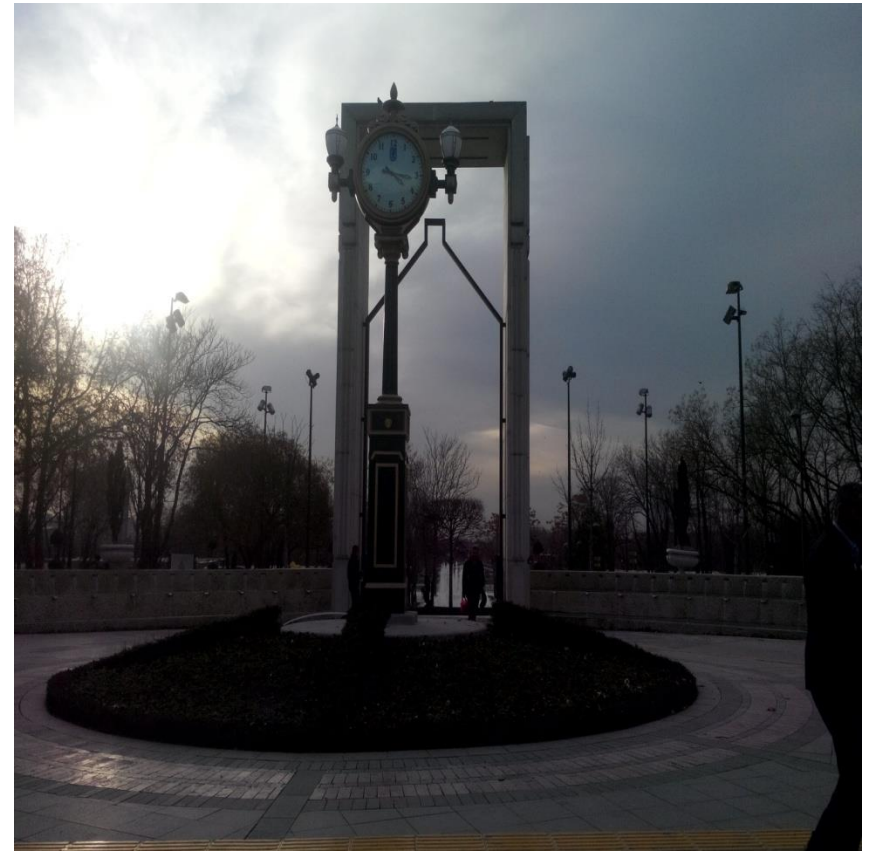




ULUS IS THE OLD FACE OF ANKARA...
