
Ankara Castle



- Having been controlled by Romas and Byzndian earlier. It was captued by Seljuq Turks in 1073 by crauders in 1101 and again by Seljuqs in 1227.

There are mausoleums of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk the leader of the Turkish War of Indepence and the pounder and first President of the Republic of the Turkey. Mustafa Kemal Atatürk' s grave there.



Roman Baths of Ankara



- The baths are located on a plateau, traditionally known as Çankırı Kapı, which rises 2.5 meters above the west side of Çankırı Caddesi, about 400 meters from the centre of the old Ankara district of Ulus, and has been identified as a höyük with Roman, mixed with Byzantine and Seljuk, material at the top and Phrygian settlement material at the base.
- The ancient city of Ancyra stood at the crossroads between the East and West and during the Roman period, the city's strategic location led to its rise to prominence as the capital of the province of Galatia.



Ethnography Museum



 The Ethnography Museum of Ankara is dedicated to the cultures of Turkish civilizations. The Museum temporaily hosted the sarcophogus of Mustafa Kemal Aatatürk from November 21, 1938 until November 10, 1953 during the period of the construction of Anıtkabir.



Ankara Central Railway Station



 The Ankara Central Station is the central train station in Ankara. The station is the busiest in Turkey, serving 181 trains daily. It is a major hub for inbound and outbound trains. There is an Ankara Metro station at its vicinity.
