- Every year, at least 150 archaeological excavations are going on in Turkey.

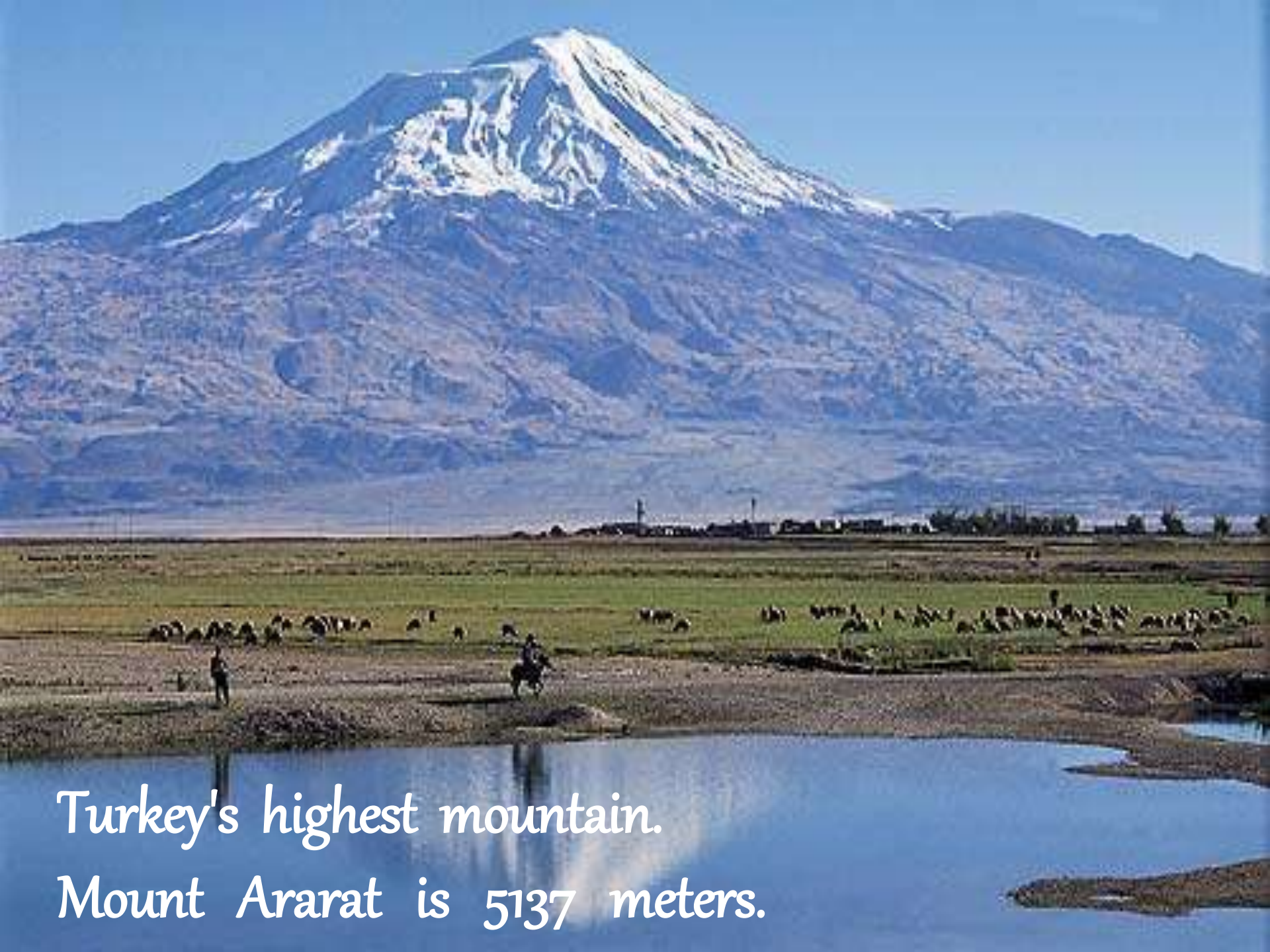




- Two of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, The Temple of Artemis and the Mausoleum at Halicarnassus, are in Turkey.

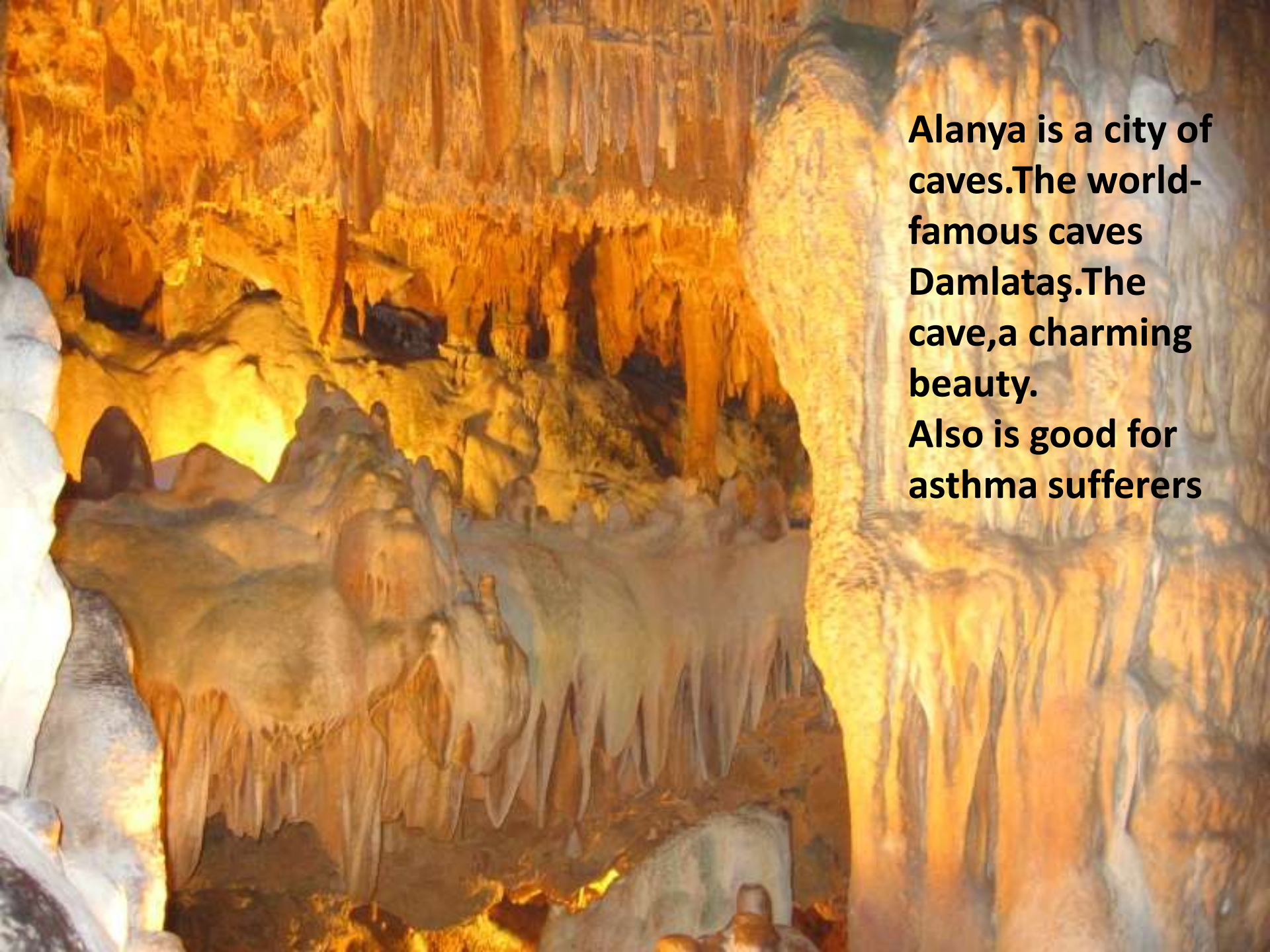




Turkey's highest mountain.
Mount Ararat is 5137 meters.



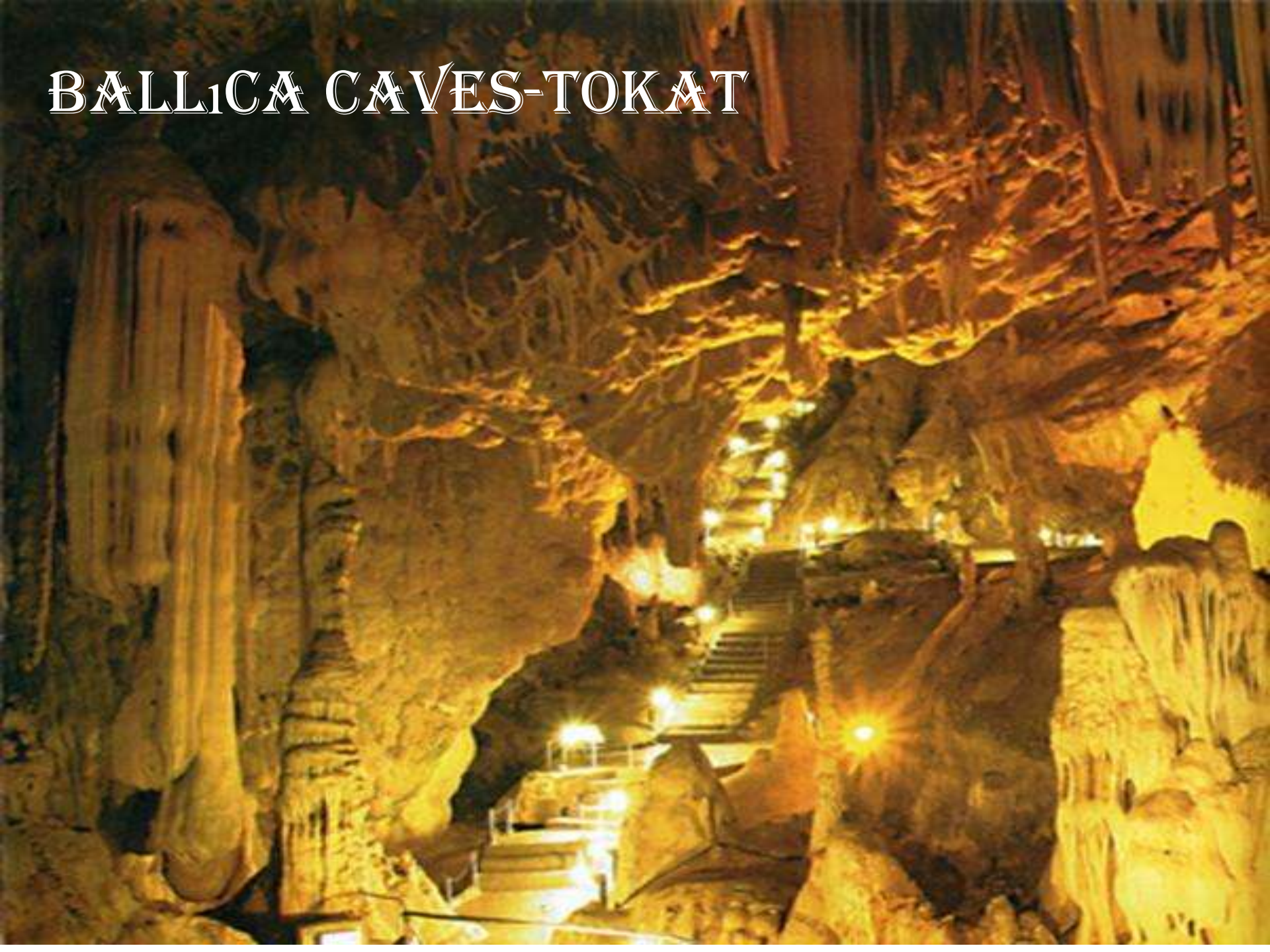
Cappadocia is one of Turkey's natural beauties. These rocks formed by wind erosion and they have a very nice view.

Olympus was one of the most significant costal cities of Ancient Lydia. Has been one of the most important tourist centers of the cultural values of the Antalya.



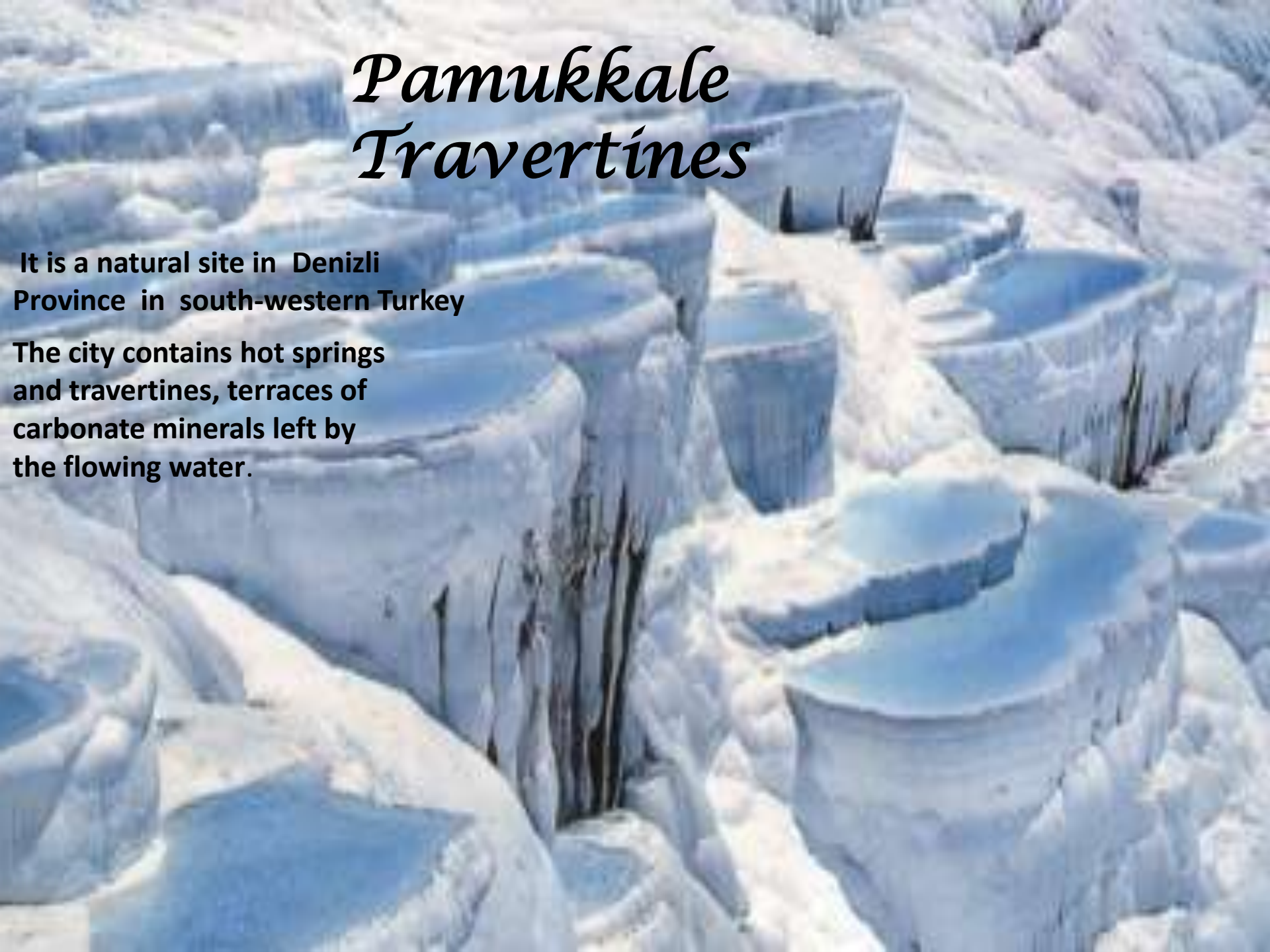

- The most important work of Mimar Sinan, Selimiye Mosque





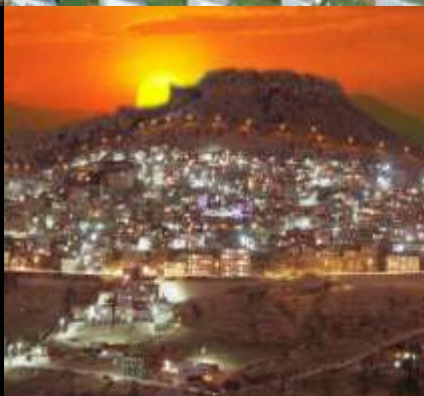
